**Abstract Submission:** The deadline for submissions of abstracts is January 15, 2007. All abstracts must be submitted via the POMS website <http://www.poms.org>. A registered author may not be allowed to present more than three papers due to scheduling conflicts. Acceptance of abstracts will be notified through e-mail by January 22, 2007. **Submission of Full Length Papers:** Submission of full length papers is not mandatory for participation and presentation of papers in the conference. However, participants may submit full length papers to be published in the electronic proceedings of the conference. POMS website <http://www.poms.org> will be available between February 15 and February 28, 2007 for submission of full length papers. Acceptance of full length papers will be notified through e-mail by March 7, 2007.
