- Paul Kleindorfer Best Sustainability and Disaster Management Paper Award. Best paper published by the Sustainable Operations and the Disaster Management departments in the preceding 4 years.

 Hau Lee Best Supply Chain Management Paper Award. Best paper published by the Supply Chain Management and the Behavioral Operations departments in the preceding 4 years.
