Who May Participate

Researchers in the field of Production and Operations Management (POM), including Operations Management, Supply Chain Management, Information Systems, Business Analytics, Operations Research, Healthcare and Marketing, from academia, government, industry, and research institutions, as well as doctoral students, are invited to submit research papers, symposium proposals, tutorials, or workshop ideas on contemporary topics in POM.

Submission Information: Interested participants are invited to submit abstracts of continuous text (no bullet points, no math/Greek symbols) no longer than 50 words describing their presentation. The title should be no longer than 15 words. Submissions should include information about all co-authors, including full name, organization, and contact email. The system will also ask to identify the name of the paper presenter.

- The colleges' mini conferences will be held on Thursday, April 22, 2027.
- The main conference will be held from Friday, April 23 through Monday, April 26, 2027. One person can present at most three papers. See important dates and frequently asked questions on the conference website after the abstract submission system opens.
