

The University of Kansas School of Business Assistant Professor of Operations Management

The University of Kansas, School of Business invites applications for a full-time, tenured/tenure-track position in operations and supply chain management at the assistant level. This position starts in August 2027. Salary and support are competitive and will be commensurate with experience.

Candidates should have a Ph.D. in a discipline directly related to operations management, supply chain management or business analytics; a strong publication record in top tier journals commensurate to that expected of a tenure-track faculty member at a research-oriented university of a similar research profile as the University of Kansas; and a history of effective teaching in the area of operations management, supply chain management, and/or business analytics.

Successful candidates will be expected to continue to contribute to the advancement of knowledge through high quality publications in leading academic journals, to teach courses with rigorous academic content at the undergraduate, masters, and doctoral level, and to engage in service and outreach activities that advance the educational mission of the School of Business and the University of Kansas.

The University of Kansas School of Business offers undergraduate, master's (full-time and online) and doctoral programs. In recent years, the School has experienced remarkable growth, expanding academic offerings with student enrollment approaching 5,000 students. The School of Business is located on KU's main campus in Lawrence in [Capitol Federal Hall](#), a modern instructional facility with advanced classrooms, offices, and student resources. Lawrence is located 35 miles west of Kansas City in the Kansas River valley.
